National Finnish R&D action for textile recycling and sustainability

Common targets are better utilization of textile waste in Finland by launching simultaneously actions and R&D projects in textile collection and sorting as well as processing and product development. We are building a new kind of multi-stakeholder business ecosystem around textile recycling, and preparing this ecosystem and society for the circular economy transformation in the fields of textiles.




Figure 2. Organizations involved in Telaketju R&D Action in 2017-2018

Telaketju R&D action started 2017 via two projects (see Figure 1) doing close co-operation and having common R&D actions. Main funding bodies for years 2017-2018 are Ministry of Environment and Tekes/Business Finland. Altogether 32 organizations are involved within these two projects as partners and /or funders (see Figure 2).
